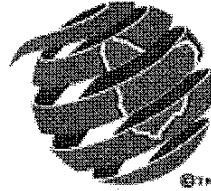

RE: **Touring Permits**

Clubs are reminded of section 6 of the Competition Rules

6. Intrastate and Interstate Matches

- a) At all times during a playing year a Club shall make its players available for such interstate, intrastate or representative matches as may from time to time be conducted, organised or controlled by the Company.
- b) If a member wishes to send a team overseas, such member shall provide the Company with full details of its proposed itinerary together with supporting letters from the governing body proposed to be visited, and upon receipt of such material written permission for the visit shall be obtained by the Company from Football Federation of Australia in accordance with FIFA Rules and Regulations.
- c) No member shall send a team to play any match interstate without first obtaining the written consent of the Company.
- d) The Company may in its absolute discretion refuse to give its approval for a member to send a team interstate and shall not be required to give any reason for such refusal.
- e) No member shall host a match against an interstate team without first obtaining the written consent of the Company. Written consent will only be given to matches or tournaments that adhere to FIFA Laws of the Game. No variations to the FIFA Laws will be approved.
- f) The Company may in its absolute discretion refuse to give approval for a member to host a match or competition against any opposition and shall not be required to give any reason for such refusal.

We have revised the process by which clubs and associations apply for permission to tour.

Interstate

Associations or Clubs should complete the Interstate Touring Permit attached for each team travelling interstate. All details including FFA registration numbers need to be completed for each player. The completed form should be returned to FFT a minimum of four weeks prior to the tour for approval.

Once approval is given the form will be countersigned and returned to the club.

Overseas

All overseas tours need to be approved by both FFT and then Football Federation Australia. I have attached the Overseas Touring application form required by FFA.

REQUIREMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE AFFILIATED STATE BODY :

1. Full Itinerary, including the purpose of the tour, including dates, match schedules, venues, accommodation etc.
2. The State / Territory / Federation / Association / to whom the club or team is affiliated
3. Name, Address, Phone Number of Club and contact person
4. Names, Club and Registration numbers of the Players travelling
5. Name, contact address and phone numbers of adults travelling as supervisors, coach, manager.
6. Child Protection declarations, where applicable, counter signed by the Tour Supervisor
7. Player and accompanying staff, travel, sickness and accident insurance.
8. Invitations from any clubs or countries for matches
9. Appropriate Visa for the country to be toured.
10. Approval letters from the players club and school
11. Approval letter from the appropriate State / Territory / Federation
12. Appropriate inoculations pertaining to the country being toured by the party.

Copies of all requirements must be forwarded by the STATE ASSOC/FEDERATION/TERRITORY to the FOOTBALL FEDERATION AUSTRALIA for sanction, with their approval or reason for rejection.

Please Note: All applications MUST be submitted no less than 30 days prior to departure. Sanction will not be given should the application not be complete or not contain approval from the State Assoc/Federation/Territory.

Upon sanction from the Football Federation Australia the appropriate National Body will be informed by the Football Federation Australia of the tour and the Itinerary of the party.
